Reading	<p align="center">Make simple predictions with evidence from the text and pictorial cues Identify and describe the main characters, settings and events Use text as a reference when answering literal retrieval questions</p>
Writing	<p align="center">Plan writing linked to the structure, vocabulary and grammar Draft and write by building on vocabulary and a range of sentence structures Evaluate and edit</p>
Science	<p align="center">Compare how things move on different surfaces Notice that some forces need contact between 2 objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance Observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials Describe magnets as having 2 poles Predict whether 2 magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing</p>
