

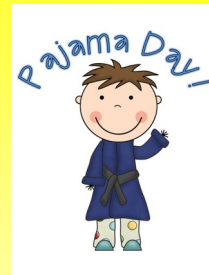
SAH BULLETIN 17 – 7th February 2023 - this is the **seventeenth** Bulletin of the academic year (2022-2023).

NEWS & UPCOMING EVENTS

Pyjama/Onesie Day—TOMORROW—Wednesday, 8th February.

The School Council are organising a fundraising event **TOMORROW Wednesday, 8th February** to raise money for **Chloe & Sophie's Special Ear Fund** (<http://www.cssef.org.uk/>). This charity has helped a couple of our hearing impaired children in the past and provides wonderful resources for those that need them. Children can come to school wearing their PJs/onesies in exchange for a small donation (min. 50p please). Please ensure that appropriate shoes and layers are worn and that coats are still sent in if cold. Thank you



- **Spare shoes and socks** - Please ensure that **EVERY MONDAY and FRIDAY**, when the children come to school in their PE kits, that they have SPARE SHOES and SOCKS to change in to afterwards. Often feet can get cold and muddy, especially if they are on the school field. Thank you.
- **Forest School Sessions** - run every Tuesday. Please refer website (under 'School Life tab and then Calendar of Events) for a reminder of the all the dates . Children who have a session in the morning will need to come to school **wearing** their Forest School clothes with their uniform in a bag and children who have a session in the afternoon will need to wear their uniform to school and **bring** Forest School clothes in a bag. **PLEASE** send appropriate Forest School clothes for the weather and dry socks and shoes for children to change into if the weather is wet.
- **MUFTI DAY - Thursday, 23rd February** - FOSAH's next event is a Mufti Day on the 23rd February. This will be in exchange for a bottle of drink (alcohol or otherwise) AND an Easter Raffle prize donation (see the attached poster for ideas). - **Year 5 Hooke Court Residential Trip** - please note that the deadline the 4th and last instalment is due by/on 28th February 2023. Please contact Mrs Eales in the school office if you have any queries regarding payment for this trip. Please ensure medical forms and consent forms have been returned to the office. Spare ones can be obtained at the **Hooke Court Meeting for parents and children THIS Thursday, 9th February at 5.30pm.**
- **Year 6 Condover Hall Residential Trip** - please note that the deadline for the 5th and final instalment for this trip was 31st January 2023. Please contact Mrs Eales in the school office if you have any queries regarding payment for this trip.
- **Year 6 Plastic Bottle Request** - after half term **Year 6** children will need an empty plastic bottle (500ml size ideally) for an art project. If your child also has some sharpie pens at home, please can you send those in too (ideally in a named pencil case). Please note you do not need to buy any sharpies especially.
