Orders after this date will include a delivery charge to your home address.
- WHOLE SCHOOL Christmas Card Orders

 design home by now. If you wish to make an order please follow the instructions on the order
 form. If you make an order, please make sure you return the artwork to classteachers by Monday,
 16th October. DEADLINE FOR ORDERS IS MONDAY, 16TH OCTOBER.
- WHOLE SCHOOL— FLU Vaccinations —please refer to the letter emailed home on 25/09. The school nursing team will be in school on 14/11 to administer the vaccines. Please use the link in the letter to give consent for your child to have their vaccine (administered via nasal spray). The closing date for e-consent is 8th November 2023



SCHOOL Attendance

Our School attendance since the start of the school year is 95.9% across the whole school.

Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority, they will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices.

STAY AT HOME

There are rare instances where your child will have to be absent from school due to illness or injury

- Temperature over 38 degrees
- Sickness & diarrhoea (48hrs absence required after last occurrence)
- Contagious illness e.g. chicken pox
- Operations/Medical Treatments
 Medical evidence should be provided to
 the school where ever possible to ensure
 the absence is authorised.

Should your child be absent for more than 5 days we request you provide supporting evidence for their absence from a medical professional.

You should also remain in regular contact with both your child's class teacher and school office.

COME TO SCHOOL

(Inform class teachers and school office)

Please send your child to school and inform their class teacher, if they are experiencing any of the following:

- Headache
- Feeling sick
- Stomach ache
- Ear ache
- Feelings of anxiety
- Twisted, sprained or broken limbs

Pupils can still partake in learning when experiencing any of the above. Please give them medication if you feel they need it at the start of the school day.

Children often feel unwell if they are anxious (e.g. worrying about a class, homework or possible sanction)

If in doubt, please contact the school office.

COME TO SCHOOL

Please send your child to school if they are experiencing any of the following:

- Sore throat
- Cold
- Mild cough
- Feeling tired
- Hay fever
- Achy or sore limbs

Pupils can still partake in learning when they are experiencing any of the above. You can give them medication first thing if you feel they need it or speak to class teachers or school office.

The school office will always contact you if your child is ill during the school day
