Christmas Fair on Saturday, 25th November 2023


From 11am until 2pm

There will be a silent auction, lots of gift stalls for all ages, some fun games to play, cakes to buy and of course a visit from Father Christmas himself.


There will also be refreshments for everyone to enjoy and a fantastic raffle with great prizes up for grabs.
