Asking for basic requirements – go to bathroom, have a drink Counting to 12 and expressing age. Cultural awareness through different events and activities - learning simply about various cultural events, with vocabulary to match. Beginning to think about further aspects of French conversation, such as weather. Lots of speaking and listening, with songs and videos to support.</p>	<p>Counting fluently to 20. Classroom instructions – listen and respond correctly. Learning to identify members of the family and talk about them. Identifying determiners and how they are used in French. Identifying the gender of nouns and recognising that this plays a strong part in language learning. Connecting members of the family to one another – my brother, his sister etc. Using determiners and basic pronouns. Using basic adjectives – tall, short etc - descriptions Beginning to use masc/fem noun-adjective agreement. Counting family members – plural, singular Vocabulary - classroom items. Asking for an item – question and verb. Counting classroom items – plurals and numbers. Describing classroom items – noun-adjective agreements.</p>	<p>The body – vocabulary, singular/plural. Expressing illness or injury to specific parts of the body. Using body vocabulary in description. Prepositions. Animals: Learning to identify names of domestic pets. Practising conversations: asking and answering questions about owning a pet. Changing question forms: Do you have an animal? Do you have a dog? Changing from the definite to the indefinite article, using the correct gender. Using colour to identify pets. Describing and talking about pets, using appropriate adjectives. Counting animals – plural, singular. Introducing phonics more formally. Introducing BANGS.</p>	<p>Investigating the Rainforest. Geographic links – French Guiana.
