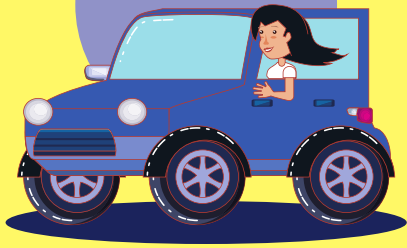

Polite Reminder



Thank you to all the parents who drive and park around the school site with due care and attention. We understand that drop off and pick ups can be extremely busy and your patience is greatly appreciated.

Every term we like to take the time to remind parents of some 'suggestions' to ease the congestion.

- Please avoid turning right into the school gates - this helps ease congestion in at least one direction at our busiest times.
- Please also avoid trying to turn right into Trumps Mill Lane (by the post box). However, please be aware that the cars turning in may belong to residents who need access to the road.
- Please remain in the correct lane to collect or drop off your child - left lane for Years 3 & 4 and right lane for Years 5 & 6.
- If your child is walking off site at the end of the day please ensure you have completed a consent form by clicking [HERE](#)
- Please can we remind you that no child should be left unattended at morning drop off until a member of staff is on the main gates (from 8.30am).
- Please also remember that the school day starts at **8.45am promptly**. If your child arrives later than this they will be marked as late. **We ask all parents who arrive late (after 8.45am) to accompany their child into school to sign them in at the office via the ipad please.**
- When collecting from clubs we ask parents to park up where possible (in the allocated parking spaces) and walk back to collect your child from the reception area. Collection from pre-teach and booster group sessions after school work in the same way as the end of the day with Years 5 & 6 children being taken to the grass area in the middle and Years 3 & 4 being taken to the playground.

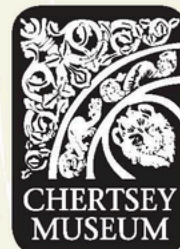
