Welcome to the first bulletin of the year. These newsletters come out regularly to inform parents and carers of the key dates and information from school. IMPORTANT INFORMATION regarding PICK UP and DROP OFF

For normal drop off and pick up arrangements, we ask that parents do not park on site or exit cars unnecessarily to ease congestion. If you do need to enter the school building for any reason at the beginning or end of the day, please park in one of the car parks nearest to the road. Please **DO NOT** leave your car unattended in the drop off/ pick up zone. Please also note that we do not allow dogs on site (this includes dogs being carried).

Please display your child's name in your car windscreen at pick up each day. This really helps speed up collection time. Thank you.

We operate a no right-turn into school at drop off and pick up time as this does ease the congestion in and around school. Please do adhere to this as it really does make a difference. Please also note that turning right in to Trumps Mill Lane (by the post box) may also cause congestion so if possible please approach school from the Thorpe Green direction. We appreciate that this might not be the easiest or most direct route for you to take but it makes an enormous difference to the traffic at the beginning and end of the day and also keeps our neighbours happy.

If your child is in Year 5 & 6 and you would like your child to walk out of school to meet you (or to walk home) please ensure you have completed the consent form by clicking [HERE](#).

If you need to visit the school during the school day please follow the clear instructions on the key pad on the entrance gate. Press 'CALL 1' to call the school office and they will let you in.

The first couple of weeks of a new year is always very busy so please bear with us, as clubs start up and parents become familiar with timings and their travel plans, you will find it becomes easier.


