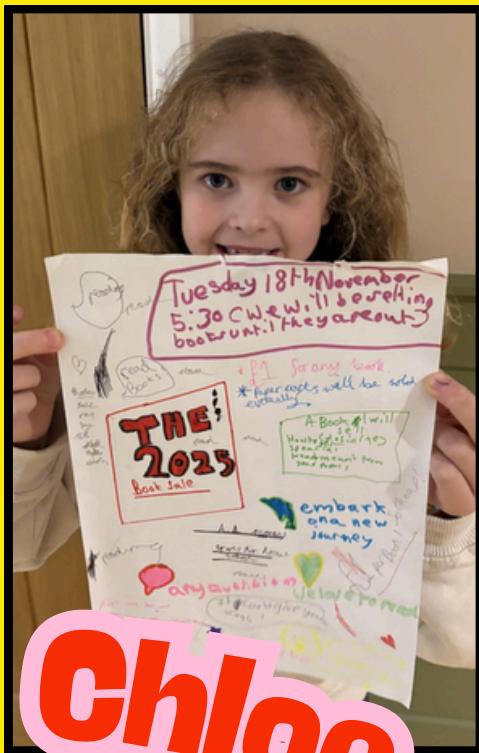
# Achievements out of School
