To book a place for your child, please use the link provided in the email and ensure that your child has a bike that meets the course requirements.

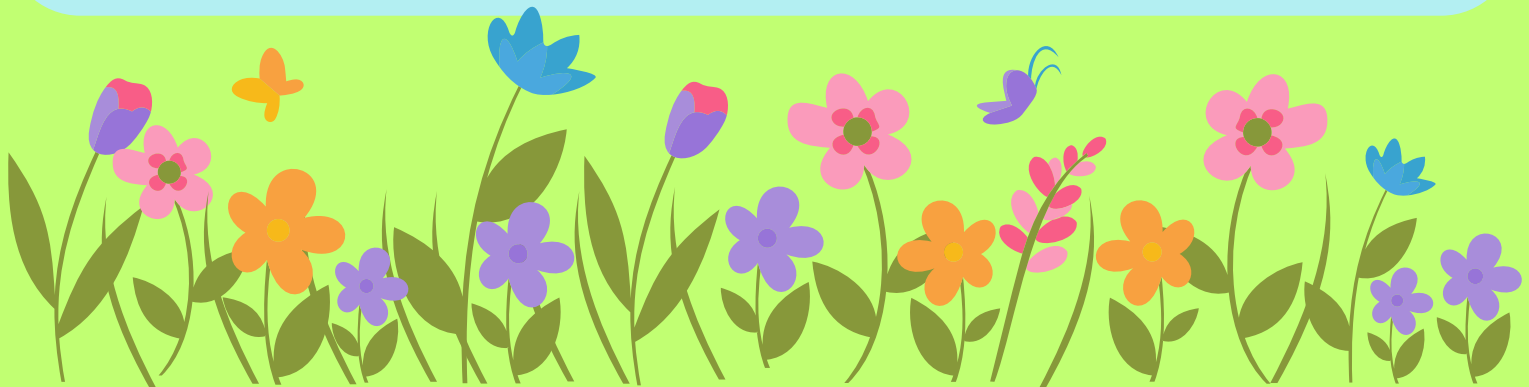
### Year 6 – JCA Residential Trip

Tickets are 50p - cash can be given to classteachers. Teachers will write the child's name onto a raffle ticket and then they will be entered into a draw.

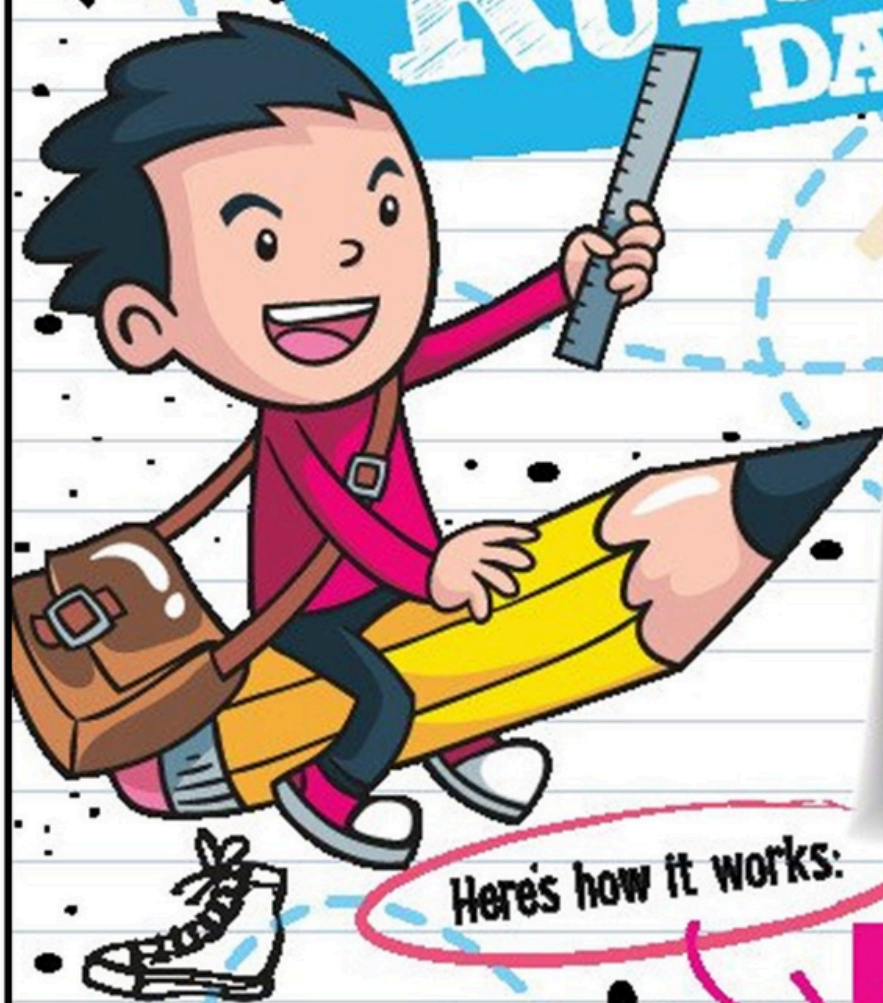
The raffle will be drawn at the end of term, and winners will take home a lovely Easter egg prize.

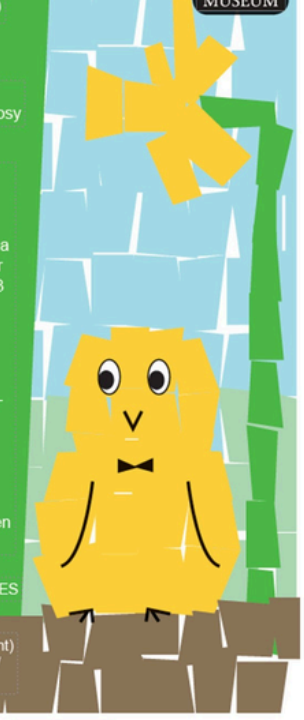
