# KEEP THEM SAFE CHECK THEIR PHONE



A friendly reminder to take time to check your child's mobile phone and keep them safe online.



## WHY IT MATTERS

Children can be exposed to things online that may upset, confuse or put them at risk. Regular checks and conversations help you keep them safe and support positive online habits.

**TALK, LISTEN, SUPPORT**  
Keep talking to your child about their online life. Make sure they know they can come to you.

## KEY APPS TO CHECK



### WHATSAPP

- Check privacy settings (profile photo, status, last seen, about).
- Who can add them to groups?
- Review chats and who they are talking to.
- Encourage them to block and report anything uncomfortable.



### SNAPCHAT

- Use 'Ghost Mode' and 'Who Can Contact Me' settings.
- Check who can view their story.
- Review friends list regularly.
- Remind them not to share personal or location information.



### TIKTOK

- Set account to Private.
- Review who can comment, stitch or duet.
- Use Screen Time management.
- Explore content together and talk about what's appropriate.



**IMPORTANT: THESE APPS HAVE AGE LIMITS. THEY ARE NOT SUITABLE FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL AGED CHILDREN.**



### WHATSAPP

**13+** YEARS OLD

Minimum age is 13.

Primary school aged children should **NOT** be using WhatsApp.



### SNAPCHAT

**13+** YEARS OLD

Minimum age is 13.

Primary school aged children should **NOT** be using Snapchat.



### TIKTOK

**13+** YEARS OLD

Minimum age is 13.

Primary school aged children should **NOT** be using TikTok.

## PRIVACY SETTINGS & PARENTAL CONTROLS



### CHECK PRIVACY SETTINGS

Make sure accounts are private and information is only visible to trusted people.



### USE PARENTAL CONTROLS

Use built-in tools on phones and apps to limit what they can see and do.



### SET SCREEN TIME LIMITS

Agree healthy time limits and tech-free times (e.g. at bedtime and mealtimes).



### KEEP ACCOUNTS SECURE

Use strong passwords and two-factor authentication where possible.

### USEFUL CONVERSATION STARTERS

- What apps do you use the most?
- Who do you talk to online?
- Have you seen anything that made you feel worried or upset?
- Do you know where to go for help?

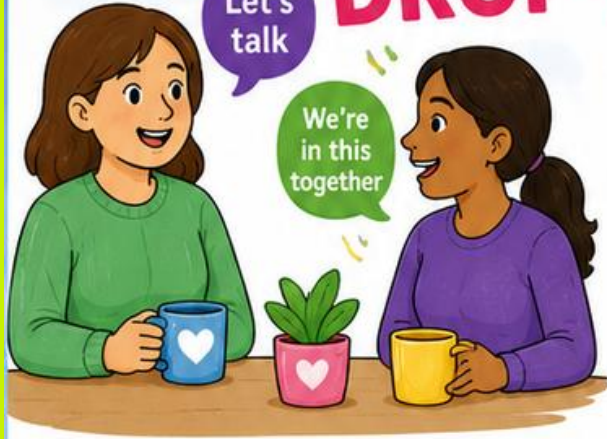

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS



## ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

Every day in school counts towards your child's learning, progress and friendships.



## CAN I TAKE MY CHILD ON HOLIDAY DURING TERM TIME?



**NO** – holidays during term time are not authorised.



Schools are only allowed to grant leave in **exceptional circumstances**.



## WHAT HAPPENS IF I TAKE MY CHILD OUT OF SCHOOL?



The absence will be recorded as **unauthorised**.



You may be issued with a **Penalty Notice (fine)**.



Your child's attendance could be affected.  
(Below **90%** = Persistent Absence)



## PENALTY NOTICE INFORMATION



**£80** per parent, per child (if paid within **21** days)



**£160** per parent, per child (if paid within **28** days)



Applies when a child has **5 or more days** of unauthorised absence.



## WHY DOES IT MATTER?



Lost learning time



Missed friendships and experiences



Falling behind in lessons



## WHAT SHOULD I DO INSTEAD?



Plan holidays during **school holidays**.



Check term dates in advance.



## NEED TO REQUEST LEAVE?



Speak to the school office **BEFORE** making any arrangements.
