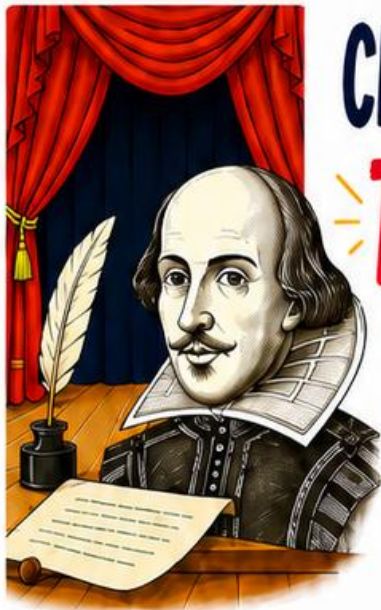
Due to an issue with the man hole covers on the field, Sports Day has been postponed and will now take place on:

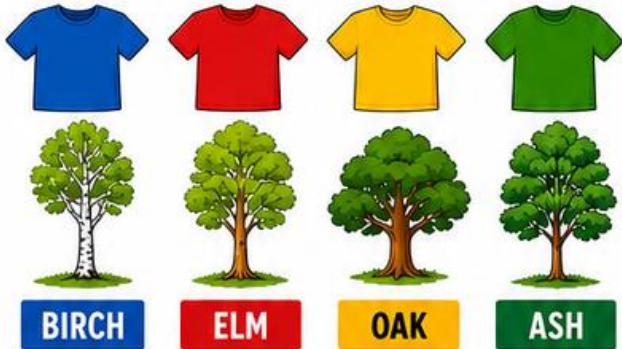

CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT NEEDED



Please send your child to school dressed in their PE kit but wearing something in their team colour, preferably a t-shirt.

Please do not allow your child to dye their hair or wear face paint and we ask that children are not wearing football kits. Team colours are as follows: blue for Birch, red for Elm, yellow for Oak and green for Ash.

ACCESS TO SCHOOL SITE

To ensure the safety of our children, we will **NOT BE** opening up the school for parking this year. There will be **NO PARKING** on school site, apart for disabled parents/ carers who have a disabled badge.

P There is plenty of parking at Virginia Water shops which is only a 10-minute walk away.

We ask that you park considerately, safely and not on the main road.

Please enter the field through the double gates by the main road.



DURING THE EVENT

- ★ Parents and carers are warmly invited to join us and cheer on their children as they participate in the different races.
- ★ Parents will be able to set up on the main school field from 12.30.
- ★ Parents will be sitting on the banked area on the far side of the field. Please feel free to bring chairs or picnic blankets to sit on.
- ★ Children will be seated in their year groups in the middle of the track. We do ask that parents/ carers and other family members do not come to where the children are seated at any point during the event. Children need to remain in the care of the teachers and support staff.
- ★ There are toilets situated in the Den that can be used during the event.



AFTER THE EVENT

- ★ Children **WILL NOT** be dismissed to their parents/ carers or other family members from the field due to safeguarding reasons.
- ★ After the events have finished, the children will make their way back into school to be dismissed in the usual way at 3.15pm.
- ★ We ask that parents use the normal system of collecting their children at the end of the day.

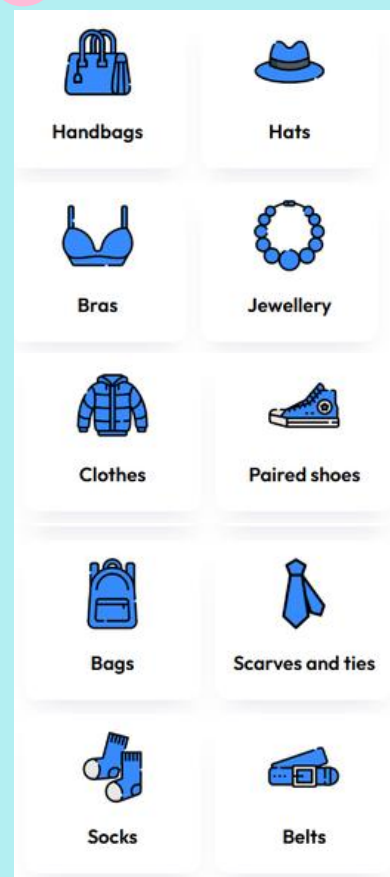
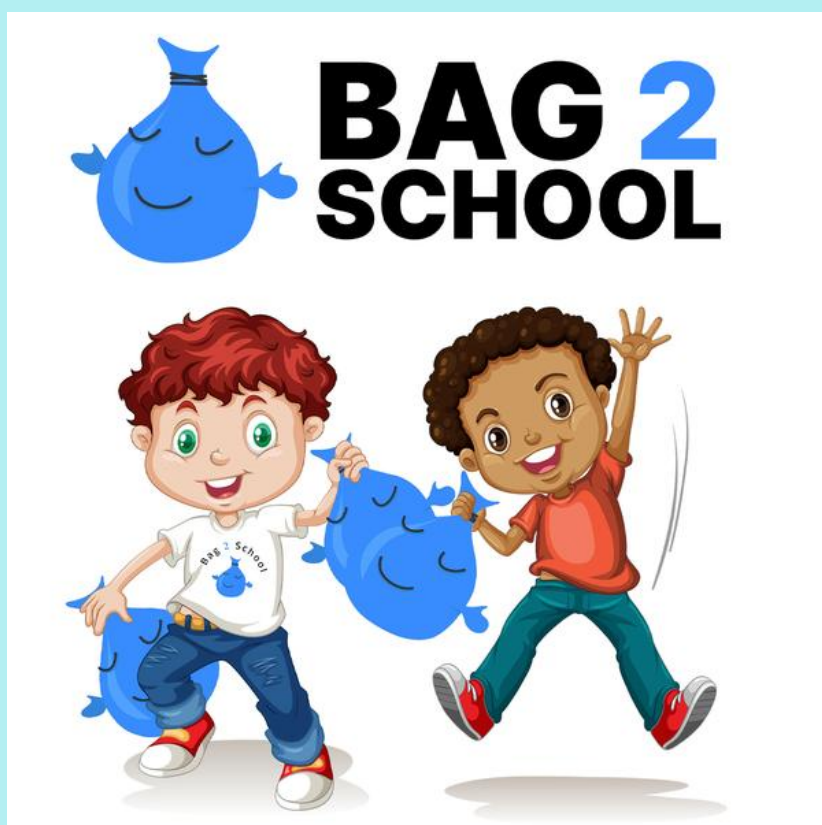






NEXT COLLECTION DATE

Friday, 3rd July



Bag2School is the UK's leading textile recycler and fundraiser working with schools and since its inception in 1999 it has now paid out over £48 million.

As well as raising vitally needed funds for our school, it also helps the environment by helping to divert good quality unwanted textiles away from landfill. A recent DEFRA report has shown that textile collection schemes are helping to reduce the volume of textiles discarded as municipal solid waste. However, it is a fact that as a nation we still send 350,000 tonnes of textiles to landfill every year.

By getting involved in our Bag2School collection, you have an opportunity to sort through your cupboards and wardrobes and donate good quality unwanted textiles in the bag provided – this can include adults' and children's clothes, shoes (tied together please), hats, belts and handbags, (please refer to <https://bag2school.com> for full details). In addition to raising much needed funds it will also raise awareness amongst the children of the benefits of recycling and reuse.

You can fill the donation bag (which will be coming home shortly) and if you still have more then you can use any other large bags (e.g. black sacks) to donate your items. Don't forget to ask grandparents, friends and neighbours to have a sort out as well!

Bag2School will be collecting from St Ann's Heath on FRIDAY, 3rd July. Please bring your bag (or bags!) to school **DROP OFF** on that day and help us have a really good collection.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

Every day in school counts towards your child's learning, progress and friendships.



CAN I TAKE MY CHILD ON HOLIDAY DURING TERM TIME?



NO – holidays during term time are not authorised.



Schools are only allowed to grant leave in **exceptional circumstances**.



WHAT HAPPENS IF I TAKE MY CHILD OUT OF SCHOOL?



The absence will be recorded as **unauthorised**.



You may be issued with a **Penalty Notice (fine)**.



Your child's attendance could be affected.
(Below **90%** = Persistent Absence)



PENALTY NOTICE INFORMATION



£80 per parent, per child (if paid within **21** days)



£160 per parent, per child (if paid within **28** days)



Applies when a child has **5 or more days** of unauthorised absence.
