It can get very wet outside, so a spare pair of dry socks in your child's bag can be really helpful.

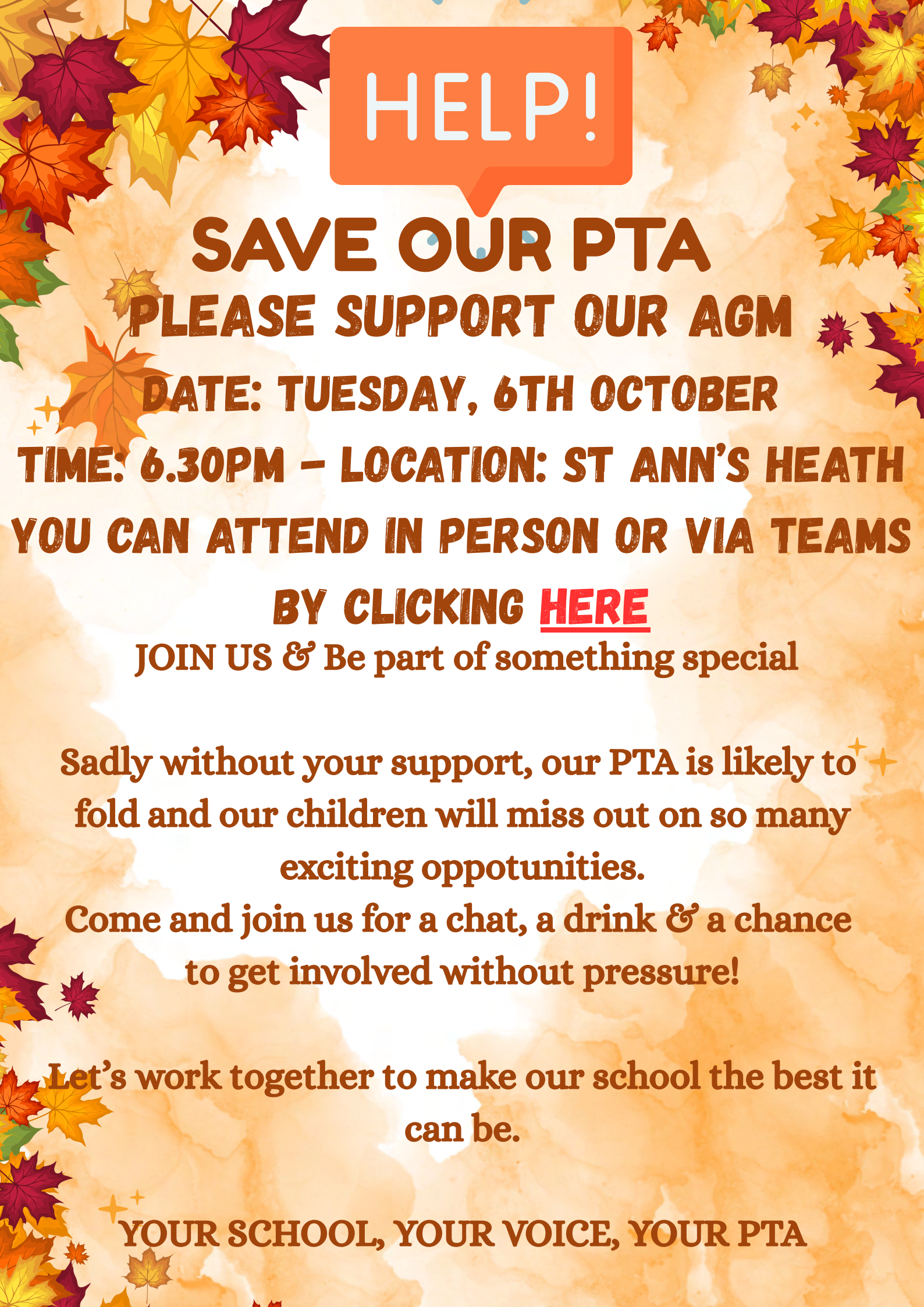

A reminder to all parents, carers and taxi drivers

For the safety of all our children and families, please take extra care when driving, parking or walking through the school site, particularly during the busy drop-off and collection periods.

1 Please do not turn right during peak times

To help keep traffic moving and reduce congestion, we encourage all parents and taxi drivers to approach the school from the direction of St Ann's Heath and turn left into the school.



2 Use the pedestrian gate

Pedestrians, scooters and bicycles must use the pedestrian gate and designated pedestrian routes. Please do not enter through the vehicle exit gate or walk between vehicles leaving the site.

Children can be very difficult for drivers to see in this area.



3 Do not use the top car park as a shortcut

The top car park (to the right as you drive in) should not be used as an alternative drop-off route to avoid the main queue. Vehicles pulling out from this area into the flow of traffic can create a significant safety risk.



4 Use the top car park if you need to come into school

If you need to park and come into the school building, please use the top car park rather than leaving your vehicle in the Year 5/6 drop-off area.



5 Year 5/6 drop-off area – drop-off only

The Year 5/6 drop-off area is for drop-off only. Vehicles should not be left unattended and, when using this area, please park parallel to the kerb, not perpendicular to it.



6 If you arrive after 8.45am

If your child arrives after 8.45am, an adult must come into the school office to sign them in.

- Keep designs unfolded & damage free as creases & marks will show on the final print.
