With the right clothing, children can enjoy fresh air, keep active and make the most of playtime – whatever the weather!

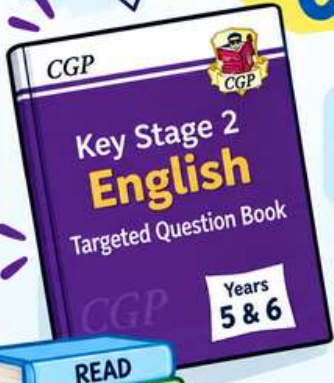

Staying Safe in a Digital World

The internet can be a brilliant place for children to learn, be creative, play and keep in touch with friends and family. It also comes with risks, so it's important that we all work together to help our children stay safe online.



DO YOU KNOW THE AGE LIMITS?

Many popular apps and social media platforms have a minimum age of 13, including:

These age limits are in place to help keep children safer. Primary school aged children should not be using these apps.

IT'S GOOD TO TALK

- ✓ What are they watching?
- ✓ What games are they playing?
- ✓ Who are they chatting to?
- ✓ Do they understand how to stay safe?
- ✓ Do they know what to do if something worries them?

Regular, open conversations help build trust and give children the confidence to come to you if they ever need support.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR PARENTS



Check regularly

Take an interest in the apps, games and websites your child is using.



Know who they're talking to

Make sure you know who your child is communicating with online.



Review settings

Look at privacy and parental control settings on devices and apps.



Keep personal information private

Remind your child not to share personal details, photos, passwords or their location online.



Encourage them to talk

Let your child know they can always tell a trusted adult if they see anything online that makes them feel worried or uncomfortable.



Age ratings exist for a reason

Follow age ratings for games, apps and films to help ensure the content is appropriate for your child.



Explore together

Where possible, watch, play or explore apps and games with your child. This helps you understand what they enjoy and any potential risks.



KEEP TALKING. KEEP CHECKING. KEEP CURIOUS.

By staying involved and aware, we can help our children enjoy the benefits of the online world while keeping them safe.
